Mini & Junior Coaches COVID-19 Session Points

- Please remind attendees that they must complete the Club COVID-19 potential symptom check list at home before attending training, matches or events and if they answer yes to any of the questions they must not attend (see Self-Assessment sheet).
- Please ensure all team players are notified via their parents/guardians to bring their own sanitiser, water bottle (and towel if needed for Jnrs) for all sessions.
- Buckets, clothes & soap have in provide and can be found in the “Laundry Room” to clean kit at recommended intervals through session, as per England Rugby Guidance.

- On setting up please use cones spaced 2m apart on one side of area to allocate a space for each player’s water bottle, sanitiser etc.
- All attendees (including parents staying on site) to be signed in each session to aid track & trace and confirm negative COVID-19 self-screening prior to attendance; as well meet England Rugby Coaching Guidance for attendance at sessions.
- Parents/guardians of M&Js required to say for safeguarding reasons are to stay on the opposite side of the pitch, again in line with current Government “Social Distance” requirements.
- It is recommended attendees on site check in using the Clubs QR code.
- Please ensure first aid kits with COVID extras are in the side pocket of kit bag so all for continuity for all First Aiders; let Pip know if you need any more supplies e-mail youthmembership@broughton-park.org.uk
- If a player/attendee has a positive COVID- 19 PCR test within 48hrs of attendance at a session, match or club event, they must notify their coach and the coach must notify Rob Loveday – Club Secretary/Youth Chairman e-mail: secretary@broughton-park.org.uk
- All players MUST now be in GMS with an RFUID to attend a session. Then new players must then register to play on GMS by session 3.
- Membership payments are a one-off transfer from the month of starting to the end of season or a monthly standing order from time of starting thought to August. These are payable via the Broughton Park Youth Rugby Account at NatWest (see payment update).
