

Create tables in a Spreadsheet and copy to a website page.

It is possible to create a table in Google Sheets, with links if you wish, and then copy the whole lot to a page in the website editor.

Eg the information page showing the routes to other clubs is much easier to create in Google Sheets and then copy the whole lot (mark and then CTRL C). Then paste (CTRL V to paste) into the Information Page in the website editor.

You will have to alter the width and height of the cells by selecting the whole table in the editor by holding the left mouse button down and drag over the table. Clicking with the right button on a mouse or two fingers on a trackpad will bring up the Tables Menu. Click on 'Cell' then 'Cell Properties'. Set the width and height of the cell. If the whole table is marked then the width and height will be set for the whole table.

Conversely if you've already setup a table in the website, it is possible to copy the table into a Google Sheet to be edited there. It can then be edited and copied back into the website editor. Delete the original table first before you copy back.

Not sure whether this will work with Excel?
